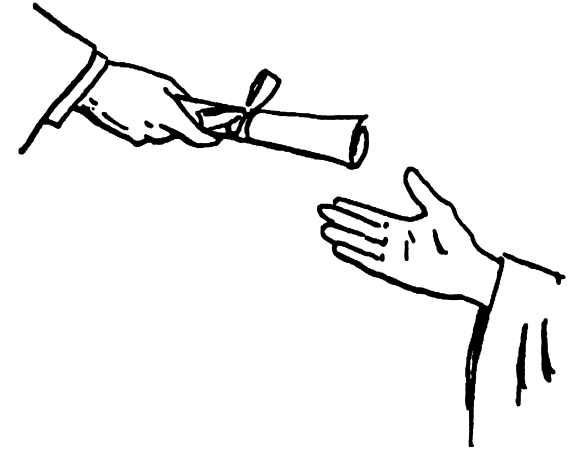

## Who will you help?

Indiana Master Masons, and/or sons, daughters, adopted sons or daughters, stepsons or stepdaughters, and orphans of Indiana Master Masons in good standing.

A Master Mason or the father who is a Master Mason will be the sponsor of the child you help.

A scholarship application may be obtained from your Lodge. The application is to be returned to the sponsor's Lodge for the selection of the applicants.

The applicant, to be eligible for a Masonic Scholarship, must be a high school graduate who is enrolled in a certified Indiana College or University as a full-time undergraduate student.

Scholarship applications are received by the Worshipful Master and Secretary of their sponsor's Lodge after Founder's Day. Selection will be based on several criteria such as financial need, leadership, moral character, community service and evidence of academic achievement.

Your gift will generate scholarships for applicants who will be college freshmen, sophomores, juniors, or seniors. If the recipient maintains satisfactory grades, he or she will be eligible for additional scholarships because of your support for the scholarship program.
